Wealthy Americans Are the IRS's Largest Target

Encino, CA—Recent reports show that Americans earning over 1 million dollars per year are a greater [IRS audit](#) target than someone earning less than \$200,000 a year. According to a recent article in the [LA Times](#), million-plus earners were audit targets at a rate of 12.5% in fiscal 2011, this is up from an 8% increase in 2010 and a 6% increase in 2009. Said another way, audits of consumers making a million dollars or more have more than doubled (up 100%) since 2009. The audit rate under a million is 1%.

Now, does the average CPA or attorney know that? Probably not.
